

Early Childhood Screening



Early Childhood Screening is a FREE check of a young child's health and development and is conducted by qualified professionals. Screening helps identify specific needs a child may have including:



- Fine and gross motor skills
- Speech and language development
- Cognitive and social development
- Vision and hearing
- Height and weight
- Immunizations

Screening should be done soon after a child's third birthday and is required by the state of Minnesota before kindergarten entry into public school.
