Students Accepted into the Internship Program must also enroll into the Seminar Class. This is a MDE requirement.

Genesys Works Students will enroll into the Business Internship/Seminar courses.

Students interested in **teaching** will enroll into the **Health Internship/Seminar courses.**

Seminar Class

Meets everyday during 4th hour

- Students are dismissed at 12:30 to work or class
- Hybrid option for PSEO students to attend online

Class curriculum includes

- Job readiness skills
- Career exploration
- Community involvement

Internship: Job Requirements

- Hour Requirements:
 - 360 hours for the school year
 - 120 hours each trimester
 - 10 hours per week
- Drivers License: Must have transportation from BHS to job
- Performance review: completed by the employer at the end of each trimester

- All jobs must be paid
- Most jobs are entry level positions (especially in the medical careers)
- Internship coordinators will guide students in finding jobs, it will be the students responsibility to get and keep the job
