- All FICTION books in the IMC are arranged by author's last name (alphabetical order)
- The author's ENTIRE last name appears on the label on the book's spine

#3) Recommendations!

- Friends you tend to enjoy the same things your friends do (that's why you're friends ☺)
- Family you tend to share the same values and beliefs
- Teachers
 - Ms. Buesing, Ms. Marquis = work around books all day long!
 - ME I like to read what teens like to read!
 - Your OTHER TEACHERS like to read, too ©

- Read the COVER (front, back, inside)
