Advanced Algebra Course Syllabus

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Materials: pencils, folder, and graph paper notebook

Behavior: We expect students to follow school and classroom rules. We expect students to be respectful, be prepared, and be on time. We will work with students, parents, and other staff members to find solutions and assign consequences for any behavior problems that disrupt learning.

Participation: Students will be required to work both individually and in groups. Students are expected to participate in class by asking, answering, and explaining questions or problems.

Assignments: Homework assignments should be completed each night and brought to class the following day. On most assignments answers are provided for the students. The homework is practice for the unit test and will be enter as missing, 1, 2, or 3. **All assignments must be turned in to retest.**

Quizzes: There will be quizzes for each chapter.

Tests: Each unit will have at least one test. The tests will be organized by target. Students will be allowed an opportunity to retest on learning targets provided there is no missing homework and the retest packet is completed for that learning target.

Absences: Students who are absent should check with the teacher upon return for their missing work.

Extra help: Extra help is available before school from 7:10-7:35 M-T, TH-F and after school 2:30-2:50 M-F in the MSRC. Other opportunities for extra help include advisement time and the lighthouse program.
