ACTIVITY 3 Math Match Up

PURPOSE:

Students will have experiences with structured quantities. They may need to count each item, initially. Over time, students should be able to recognize the quantity on the card without counting.

SUPPLIES:

2 sets of cards (such as finger patterns and dot cards)

GOAL:

All kindergarten students will be able to recognize quantities structured on five frames, dot patterns, ten frames and finger patterns – up to and including ten.

TIMELINE:

Students may move on to the variations when they are comfortable with initial procedures listed below.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Select 2 sets of 5 cards for the targeted range.
- 2. Place the cards face up in a 2 by 5 array.
- 3. Students take turns finding 2 cards that represent the same amount, saying the numbers for each card.
- 4. If the cards represent the same amount, the student has a match.

VARIATIONS:

- Play with one set of numeral cards and one set of finger patterns within the same range.
- Play with one set of numeral cards and one set of frames within the same range.
- Play with 2 sets of numeral cards within the same range.

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
