Quizzes/Tests:

Tests: Tests will be given at the end of each chapter. NO phones/tablets/smart watches allowed on tests and will need to be placed in your backpack and placed in the front of the room during testing. If a student is caught with a phone out during a test, the test will not be scored.

Retests: Retests are allowed if all homework is done and turned in by the initial Chapter Test.

Classwork/Assignments:

Classwork will be assigned at various times throughout the trimester and may or may not be collected and/or scored. Assignments will be given at the completion of each unit and are essential for learning. Students will be expected to check their answers and seek assistance if they are struggling with understanding. Assignment answers will be posted on google classroom and should be used as a tool for correcting and assistance. Working together on assignments is encouraged.

Absences and Make-up Policy:

In the event a student is absent from school, it is their responsibility to get the notes from google class room or another student and to get help needed on anything they missed. If a student is absent on a test day, they WILL BE expected to take the test on the day they return. If they are absent on a review day, they will still be expected to take the test.
