# BLAINE COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## HISTORY AND PURPOSE

The objective of the Blaine Community Scholarship Program, which has been in existence since 1976, is to raise money from the community of the area served by Blaine High School. The purpose is to offer financial assistance for post-secondary education and to help support graduating seniors with their educational goals. Scholarships are awarded based on scholastic achievement, community service and activities/athletic participation without regard to race, religion, sex or national origin.

To date, BCSP has awarded 2,858 scholarships totaling over \$144,981,925. With increasing donations and a larger number of contributors, we are now able to award scholarships at a minimum of \$500 up to \$2,500 per recipient.

The BCSP would like to express our sincere gratitude to all the organizations and individuals in our community for their support and generosity to help make our program a success. In 2024 the Blaine Community Scholarship Program awarded 101 scholarships totaling \$69,992.00
